

Prof. Dr. Tatiana P. Karpilovitch is the Head of the Department of Theory and Practice of the English Language at the School of Translation and Interpreting, Minsk State Linguistic University. She teaches English Stylistics, Theory of Intercultural Communication, she also supervises undergraduate and postgraduate student research projects. She was an IREX scholar at the Institute for Research in Cognitive Science, Pennsylvania University in 1995-1996. Her research interests include discourse linguistics, cognitive linguistics, media and cultural studies, contrastive linguistics. She is the author of the book «Modelirovanie Smyslovoi Compressii Teksta: Kognitivno-Diskursivny Podhod» (Modeling of Text Semantic Compression: a Cognitive-Discursive Approach), Minsk, 2003; editor-in-chief and one of the authors of the book «Media Text i Kultura» (Media Text and Culture), Minsk, 2015. She coordinated a number of international conferences which were held at Minsk State Linguistic University: «Young Scientists in Innovative Research», «Contrastive Studies of Languages and Cultures».
