Professor, D. Litt.

Member of faculty of the Department of English and American Studies, University of Sofia, since 1975.

Taught a number of courses including *Introduction to General Linguistics, Language Typology, Cognitive Linguistics, Semantics, History of English Vocabulary, Worldviews and Languages, English Word Formation, Mythology and Mythmaking in Advertising.*

Also lectured or taught courses at UCLA, University of Reading, University of Helsinki, University of Leeds, King's College London, University of Lisbon, Catholic University of Portugal at Viseu, the Sorbonne (Paris IV), University Blaise-Pascal at Clermont-Ferrand, Free University at Berlin, and the University of Seoul.

Served on the Specialized Academic Board on Linguistics and chaired the Specialized Academic Board on Classical and Modern Languages.

Vice-Rector of the St Kliment Ohridski University of Sofia, Dean of the Faculty of Classical and Modern Languages and Head of the Department of English and American Studies of the same University.

Author of books and articles on word formation, semantics, typology and universals, cognitive linguistics and language origin. Also author of a series of course books in English (I to XII grade) and translator of many books.
